

Farming scholarships available for Maori

MAORI high school leavers and those interested in agriculture need to act now if they want to take advantage of scholarships still available to cover tuition for a level three Certificate in Farming (dairy).

Students will be enrolled

at Lincoln University, near Christchurch, and will do practical experience on the Ngai Tahu Farming dairy farms.

Accommodation options and advice are available.

The course starts late in February and a Maori approach

to learning, as well as guidance and support through to employment is included.

This learning opportunity has been made possible via Whenua Kura, a partnership programme between Te Tapuae o Rehua, Ngai Tahu Farming and

Lincoln University, which seeks to grow Maori leadership in agriculture. Whenua Kura is open to all Maori, with scholarships available for those aged 16-40.
