Tuhoe festival

TE Ahurei o Tuhoe organising committee Te Komiti Iti has lowered entry prices to the biennial festival, held by the tribe to celebrate its traditions and connections.

This year the four-day event starts on March 25 and an adults day pass will cost \$10, with weekend passes set at \$20.

Young people (those aged 14 to 19) can access the ahurei for \$5 for the three days.

Those younger than 13 and Goldcard holders have free entry.

The committee has also announced that eftpos will be available at the entry gates for the first time since the festival began in 1971.
