

Taneatua liquor licence application

OWNERS of the Taneatua Liquor Store wanting to extend their business times by one hour will have their application heard today.

Now, the store closes between 2pm and 4pm to avoid the hours when school children walk past the shop. The business opens again from 4pm until 7pm.

The business has applied to renew

the store's off-licence status and has asked to be able to stay open until 3pm as children were in school until then.

A public hearing into the application by Bir Ji Suman Traders to extend the period they can operate will be held at 10am today at the Whakatane District Council chambers.
