Option 1 - Buying in, 99 years occupation right, you pay your deposit up front and for the rest the Iwi will provide a home loan which you will pay back over 15 years.

Option 2 - “Try before you buy”, 1 year occupation right, no deposit up front – weekly costs are same as if you are paying off your home loan. By the end of the year a decision is needed if you will buy-in (99 years), or exit. If buyin, you pay the deposit then.

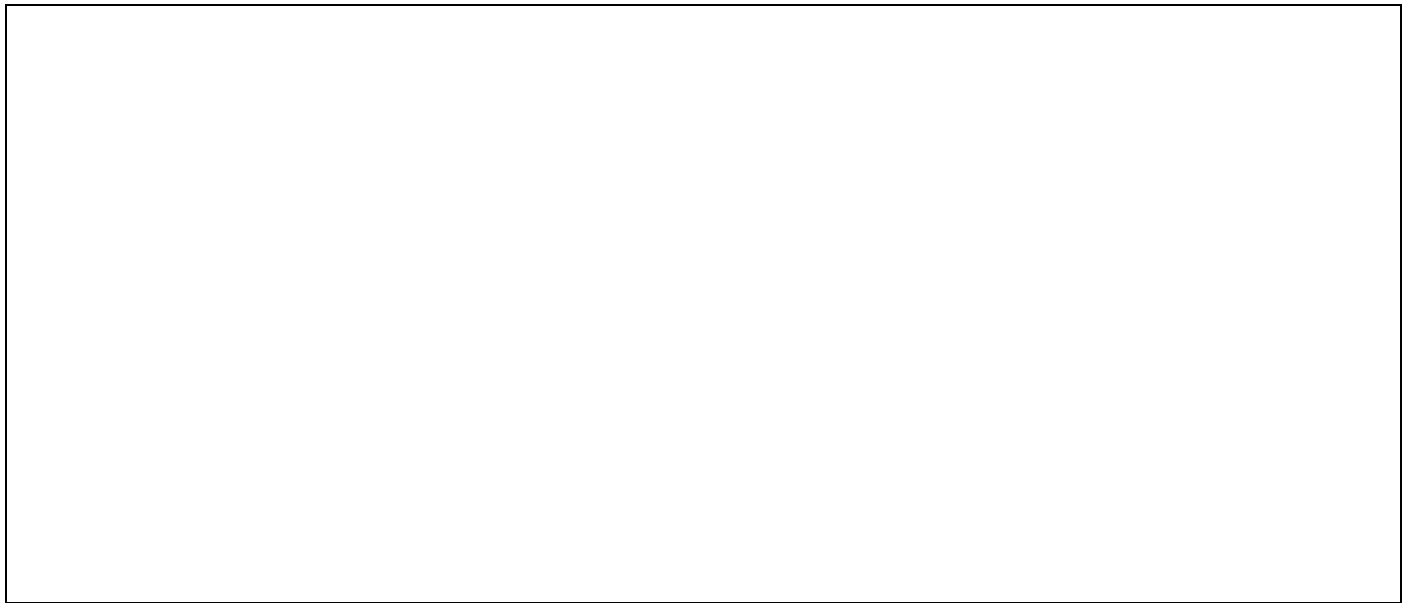
